COVID-19 information

In view of the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19) and the declaration by the World Health Organisation (WHO) of a public health emergency, Cigogne Management SA has taken all necessary measures to protect its employees, investors and business partners and ensure full business continuity. The Management of Cigogne Management has decided, in conjunction with the Risk Department of Crédit Mutuel Alliance Fédérale, to activate its Emergency and Business Continuity Plan to ensure the smooth running of all its services.

Cigogne Management has also cancelled and prohibited all business travel abroad and has asked all employees to try to hold meetings remotely (conference calls, video-conferencing). Management has decided to allow employees who designate themselves as "vulnerable" to remain off-site and work from home. The company is also encouraging its employees not to travel privately to a risk area listed on government websites. Employees returning from any of these risk areas are required to report to Management so that all necessary measures can be taken upon their return for the benefit of all.

Cigogne Management's Emergency and Business Continuity Plan is in place at the level currently required, but additional measures are already planned should the epidemic situation change.
